Progress Reports

It is hard to believe that we are already at the halfway point in Term 1! Over the past two months we have seen our students engage in many opportunities presented to them at school. Many classroom and school-based activities are available to help build your child's sense of community and leadership.

Yesterday, your child brought home their Elementary Progress Report. Although it looks much like the Report Card, the Progress Report has a very different intent. The purpose is to share early and specific feedback on your child's development of work habits and learning skills as well as their progress in specific subject areas. Reporting on the Progress Report is about looking forward and setting a course for the learning journey ahead based on the evidence that teachers have gathered thus far through their observations, conversations and student products.

The Progress Report does not include letter grades or percentage marks for academic subjects; it instead identifies whether your child is progressing very well, well or with difficulty. For subjects in which your child is Progressing with Difficulty, the teacher will discuss specific next step plans needed for success. We look forward to partnering with you and your child for a year of great learning and growth.

We have set aside Thursday, November 28th as our Teacher Interview night. Information regarding times will be shared with you by your child's classroom teacher. We look forward to the opportunity to conference with you about your child's progress at that time!
